In June 2021, Vicky Voisin was diagnosed with breast cancer and began her journey at the Terrebonne General Health System | Mary Bird Perkins Cancer Center. The following March, she had bilateral breast reconstruction surgery at Terrebonne General Hospital. Because she did not have enough tissue, the surgeon, Dr. Jeffery Rau, had to use tissue from her inner thighs and the back of her legs. Her three-day hospital stay was pleasant, and the staff and Dr. Rau ensured she was comfortable and attended to her needs. Despite their best efforts, two weeks after surgery, the wounds on her legs dehisced. She was then referred to the Terrebonne General Health System Wound & Hyperbaric Clinic.

It was a lengthy recovery, but Vicky says she always felt she was in good hands from the moment she walked in until it was time to leave. In all, she had a total of 60 daily hyperbaric treatments, except for weekends, with progress visits each Friday. “I was greeted with a smile and compassion,” Vicky explains. “I enjoyed being there.”

Vicky describes the staff as a great support system. “They were eager to see me to see how well I was healing, which inspired me to follow all the helpful advice I was given at my appointments.” She notes that Dr. Cazayoux, the nurses and entire staff went above and beyond to ensure all her needs were met at each visit. Taking it one day at a time, she was excited to eventually reach her goals.

In August, Vicky was healed. Although she was very excited, she was also a little sad because she would miss the wonderful staff that she grew so fond of over the past four months. “I appreciate all of them and will hold onto the memories I shared with everyone there.”
